



## **Pool Rules & Regulations**

### **Pool Hours: 8AM-9PM**

1. The pool is for the exclusive use of McPherson Ranch residents and their guests. Residents are responsible for the conduct of their children and guests at all times. No more than **(4) four** guests per household are permitted at one time. *Children are defined as anyone 14 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18.*
2. **Anyone that lends their pool card to another resident or guest is subject to having their pool privileges suspended for the rest of the pool season.**
3. The gates to the Amenity Center/Pool Area are to remain closed at all times and are not to be propped open or otherwise left unsecure.
4. **The Association DOES NOT employ a lifeguard** and assumes NO responsibility for the safety of any persons using the pool.
5. No large flotation devices are permitted in the pool at any time.
6. Bicycles, tricycles, skates, skateboards or scooters are not permitted within the Amenity Center/Pool Area or entryway.
7. Pool users may use only the furniture provided in the pool area, and shall not remove furniture from the pool area for any purpose (including removal for use at the playground).
8. Pool users shall not create disturbing activity or noise that may infringe on the rights, comforts or convenience of other residents.
9. The Association may change the pool rules as deemed appropriate.
10. The pool may be closed from time to time for the purpose of cleaning, adding chemicals, security, or other reasons deemed necessary.
11. No running, pushing, hitting, biting, spitting, hair pulling, boisterous play or scuffling is permitted in the pool or pool area.
12. **Diving and flips are NOT permitted.**
13. **Public intoxication is NOT permitted in the pool area. Any person suspected of intoxication will be asked to leave and risk losing all pool privileges.**
14. Any person having open wounds, skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, nasal or ear discharges or any communicable diseases shall not be permitted inside the pool.
15. Only proper swimsuits are permitted, no diapers, cut-offs or thongs. Swim diapers are permitted. No diaper changing is permitted in the pool area, except at the designated baby changing stations in the pool restrooms.
16. NO glass containers of any kind are permitted in the pool or surrounding pool area.
17. NO pets of any kind are allowed in the pool or surrounding pool area.



18. Pool users are responsible for cleaning up of any area they use. The Association will NOT be responsible for any items/articles left at the pool.
19. Large parties, defined in excess of (4) four guests are not permitted.
20. A resident will be held financially responsible for any damage or vandalism caused by him or herself, their family or their guests.
21. Climbing on pool fences, walls, shade structures, gates and furniture is prohibited.
22. Pool safety devices are located at each pool area for use in any emergency. No resident or guest shall remove or tamper with any pool safety device.
23. No eating or drinking while in the pool. Owners are responsible for disposing of trash/food properly.
- 24. NO smoking or alcohol in the pool area.**
25. Each household will be issued one gate card by the Association free of charge. If you lose your gate card, you must notify the Association immediately. There will be a \$25.00 replacement charge for each card replaced.

**REMINDER: NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY! SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK!**
